Fun spelling games for high school students

Kicking back with a great video game is a fantastic way to give yourself a break from the pressures of school. Simple games don't ask too much of your hardware, but the better, the more immersive ones require a capable PC or game console. Before you spend good money on hardware, think about the games you like to play, and then find a PC or console that runs them. Here are some basic tips to keep in mind when choosing a gaming system. Gaming PC All PC can play Tetris or Angry Birds, but if you want to engage in games like sports, first person shooters, or online multiplayer action, you need the processing and graphics horsepower required to deliver a smooth experience. And of course you need to find a system that can do that without emptying your wallet. Buying a game PC—especially on a limited budget—is an exercise in finding the right balance. The processor, graphics, storage, memory and cooling are all crucial elements to consider, as are the monitor, mouse, game controller, and other devices you need to engage in gaming. Graphics processing is probably the most critical component of a gaming system. Some processors have integrated graphics capabilities that are sufficient for day-to-day computing and low-end gaming, but first-person shooters and the like need more graphics horsepower to make your game look great and play without hooks or pixilation. If you will be playing these games, consider investing in extra memory and a graphics card like a GeForce GTX 660. In any case, before you buy a game, be sure to note the hardware requirements and check if your system measures up. There's nothing more annoying than trying to load a game and learn that your computer can't handle it. Game consoles Unlike your computer, a game console is built from the ground up to play games, so there are fewer design trade-offs. What's more, a console can also serve as a home entertainment system, complete with DVD or Blu-Ray turntables, streaming music and movies, and access to services like Netflix. The three primary game consoles are the Nintendo Wii U, Sony PlayStation 3 and Microsoft Xbox 360. Some games are available for all platforms; others are keyed to just one. The Halo series, for example, is only available on Xbox, while the Mario series is unique to Nintendo, and Gran Turismo is limited to Playstation. Bottom line: Choose a game, check your budget, and then decide what to buy. Check out this chart to get a closer look at some popular gaming systems. If you have school-age kids, you probably spent the last few weeks shopping with your kids for new clothes and buying your way through your school's list of recommended supplies. wondering — how much did you spend? I bought bought bought on my 8-year-old daughter's school list, and it cost more than \$100, not to mention the new clothes, sneakers and backpack. It's a price tag not all families can afford, and with multiple children, it can be a significant cost. My family lives in a city that is home to a large immigrant population, and nearly 70 percent of public school students qualify for free or reduced-price lunch. There is so much need in my community that the public school system recently decided to give all students free breakfast and lunch every day. And speaking of needs – let's talk about teachers. Most of them don't get enough financial support from their schools for classroom supplies, leaving them on the hook for hundreds of dollars out of their own pockets each year. (I watched this firsthand grow up, because my mother was a teacher and principal for decades. And when she was principal, she spent thousands of dollars of her own money instead of hundreds.) It was clear our back-to-school shopping list included not only supplies for our individual student, but classroom supplies as well, like boxes of tissues, packaging with printer paper and containers clorox wipes. My family is happy to send them in, because we can afford them, and we appreciate how much our public school teachers do for the children. If you are in a position to help needy students at your local schools, there are many ways to do so, both large and small. Do you know how many students need to sit in your child's classroom?. Naming/Shutterstock 1. Donate supplies. Pens, eraser, notebooks, coloring materials – as you pick these up for your child, consider grabbing an extra of each if you can swing it. Send them in with a note to the teacher that they can go to anyone who needs them. The same goes for classroom supplies such as paper towels or hand sanitizer – teachers in our district usually put out a call to them a few times a year. 2. Donate clothes. Some schools maintain a small supply of clothing - a thrift store, of sorts - to provide clothes and shoes to students or families in need. Our local primary school does this and puts out a call once a year or so for donations. This student-run clothing store in Stratham, New Hampshire, gives all the clothes away for free and it is open to everyone, regardless of need, to remove the awkwardness that some students may feel by using such a store. Call your local public schools to ask about clothing donation drops near you. 3. Give to your local food banks. You can give donations of food, time or money to food banks to help needy families in your community. Your local supermarket can make it easy with pre-packed boxes you can buy for about \$10 each and drop-off boxes where you can leave non-easily perishable items for food pantry. Around the holidays, many schools will run their own food units to benefit students and their families. Our school's notice home to families a special appeal for baby supplies - diapers, wipes, formula and food can be expensive, so they are often in high demand. We usually send in some grocery bags with supplies, and we buy them separately in the store and save the receipt for a small tax deduction. 4. Volunteer. Whether you raise your hand to go in and read to classrooms on designated days or apron a field trip, you'll get a first-hand exam on the kids in your local school. I'll never forget spending a December morning in my daughter's first class, where the kids talked eagerly about the upcoming vacation. I heard a boy say he doesn't believe in santa because Santa always forgets to come to his house. Heart-broken, I later emailed the teacher to ask if there was any way we could help, and she linked me with school social workers who could offer some options. And of course, you can consider volunteering with organizations like the Boys & Girls Clubs of America or big brothers big sisters of america, which also help children in need. 5. Adopt a student. Washington state is home to The Homes for Students's Adopt-a-Student program, which aims to match financially challenged, at-risk and homeless students with donors interested in helping these disadvantaged students attend their institution and achieve their academic dreams. The charity is helping more than 58,000 homeless students across the country. 6. Donate a washing machine. Such a generous move would definitely go beyond. But here's the thing: One in five students in the United States have trouble finding clean clothes to wear to school, according to a study of 600 teachers conducted by appliance company Whirlpool. Many parents have to use laundromats or a friend's house, which can be tricky with family scheduling, and if the money is tight, they can't buy soap. With this in mind, Whirlpool donated 17 pairs of washers and dryers to schools in St. Louis and in Fairfield, California. Children with attendance problems were able to bring in their laundry to be cleaned while they were in class. The results, according to Fox Business: Over 90 percent of students had increased attendance, and especially at-risk adolescents reported fewer absences, nearly two weeks of school.
